Important: Your Kolpin accessory is exclusively designed for your ATV. Please read the installation instructions and operator's manual thoroughly before beginning. Installation of any item is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris.

Kit Contents:

1. Quantity 1 of Switch
2. Quantity 2 of Grips
3. Quantity 1 of Wire Harness
4. Quantity 1 of Bracket Kit

Tools Required for installation:

- Phillips Screwdriver
- 10mm Socket
- 5mm Hex Allen wrench
- Sharp utility knife or chisel
- Slow setting epoxy (two-part is suitable)

Install Preparation:

1. Remove the handlebar grips from the handlebars.
2. Clean the handlebars where the heated grips are to go. Sand any roughness off handlebars.

Installation:

1. Apply a thin coat of slow setting epoxy to the handlebars.
2. With a twisting action, slide on new heated grip assemblies.
3. Verify that the wiring does not interfere with the throttle or brake controls. Make sure all wires clear any obstructions.
4. Mount switch in preferred location with supplied hardware. Switch can be mounted to handlebar tube with clamp. The clamp is fastened to the switch with supplied screws. Switch can also be mounted to flat drillable surface such as headlight pod.
5. Connect positive wire (red) to a switched (on-off) power source such as keyed ignition accessory.
6. Connect negative wire (black with ring connector) to the negative terminal on battery or equivalent.
7. Route the wires from the grips to power source wires and connect together (see wiring diagram). Ensure wires do not touch hot surfaces or make contact with moving components.
8. Turn handlebars both directions and make certain that all wires have adequate clearance. Secure wires using cable ties.
9. To verify proper installation, shift vehicle into park and start engine. Turn hand warmers on high.

WARNING: Always verify vehicle controls prior to operating vehicle with a Kolpin accessory. Do not use if there is interference with your vehicle's controls. Product is designed to fit most vehicles, however Kolpin does not guarantee vehicle fitment for all vehicles. See Kolpin.com for the latest vehicle fitment.

WARNING: The vehicle must be run in a well ventilated area. Never run engine indoors without proper ventilation. It may take several minutes for grips to warm up depending on ambient temperature and if you are wearing gloves.

WARNING: Do not over tighten hardware or damage can occur.

WARNING: Make sure that no binding is occurring when operating throttle and handbrakes.

WARNING: Do not use if product is damaged.

WARNING: This product contains a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer.

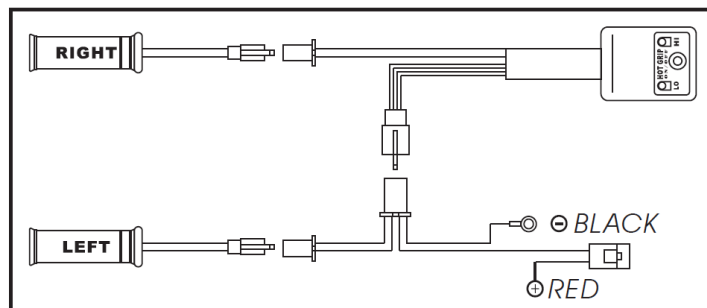


Diagram for how to connect wiring leads

One Year Limited Warranty

For the period of one (1) year from the purchase date, Kolpin will replace for the original purchaser, free of charge, any part or parts found upon examination by Kolpin to be defective in material, workmanship, or both.

All transportation costs incurred submitting product to Kolpin for warranty consideration must be borne by the purchaser. If Kolpin determines that the product must be returned to the factory for credit, please call 1-877-956-5746 for a Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number and shipping instructions.

This warranty does not apply to parts that have been damaged by accident, alteration, abuse, improper maintenance, normal wear, or other causes beyond the manufacturer's control. In order to protect you and your ATV, certain parts of the plow system and/or hardware are designed to fail when the equipment is over-stressed. Parts that are lost due to loosening and improper maintenance are not covered under warranty. This warranty does not cover removal or reinstallation labor fees of the plow system and related components.

Peripheral products such as engines, electric motors, and actuators may carry an original manufacturer's warranty. Most hardware is general in nature and is easily obtained locally. Be sure to replace with minimum metric class 8.8 specification.
